

GROUP CLASS FAQ'S

1. How much do classes cost?

- ★ Tuition for each class is \$399.00, and discounts are available if you sign up for more than 1 class. The tuition is all-inclusive, covering the registration fee, all materials, and even performance fees.
- ★ Tuition is non-refundable and non-transferable (NO EXCEPTIONS). This is why we make sure not to bill the account until 10 days after the first class attended. That way, the student can attend at least 2 classes at NO RISK to you before committing for the entire semester!

2. How long do I have before I have to sign up?

- ★ Classes begin August 25th and registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. We do accept registrations until we are full; however, the closer we get to our start date the less likely we will have availability.
- ★ The registration period closes on Saturday, October 10, 2015. No registrations will be accepted after this date.

3. How would we go about registering?

- ★ Registration may be done in-person (highly recommended), online, or over the phone (480.905.4102). Our Front Desk Team is available to take your call Monday-Friday between the hours of 1pm-7pm and 9am-2pm on Saturdays.

4. What if we cannot make it to a class? Do you offer make-ups?

- ★ We do not offer any make-up classes or refunds for classes you cannot attend.
- ★ If you are unable to make it to a class, please notify our Front Desk Staff, so that they can inform the instructor and send any necessary class materials to you, upon your request.

5. What happens if we decide we cannot continue a class midway through the semester?

- ★ In order to promote the best experience possible in all of our classes, we request that all students commit to their class until their end-of-semester showcases. We find that when students withdraw from class mid-semester, our classes dip in morale due to changes in solo assignments and choreography. Because of this, we do not offer any refunds for classes after you have committed past the 10-day risk-free registration period.

6. I am trying to register online, but the system is only allowing me to enroll for the first day and charging me \$1. How do I register for the entire semester?

- ★ Our online booking system only contains the first day of classes online in order to prevent enrollment errors. When you sign up, it sends our front desk a notification and then we process the rest of your enrollment for the school year on our side.
- ★ The \$1 charge occurs per class, and ensures that the billing information on your profile is valid. This charge will be deducted from your semester tuition when charged (10 days after your first day of class).

7. When I click on the online "Sign Up Now" button, it gives me two options. One makes a single reservation, and the other is to make a recurring reservation. Which do I select?

- ★ Either one will work. Our online booking system allows us to assign multiple days in a week to a class if we wish. Since this class meets only on one day per week, there is only one "reservation" or class.

8. We can't make any of those classes offered? Do you offer any other programs?

- ★ Yes! Speak to the Front Desk Team about our "Create Your Own Class" program! In addition, we offer weekly private lessons and a ton of fun monthly workshops!
